Located at Cronkbourne Cricket Club, Tromode Road Douglas, Isle of Man,
 IM2 5PA, just 400 metres from Bray Hill

## Reception & Wristbands

- Reception open from 7am
- Emergency contact available 24/7 outside these hours
- On arrival:
  - o Check in with your ID and booking confirmation
  - o You'll be issued a Hotel Bell Tent wristband for 24-hour access to the site

## Facilities & Amenities

You'll have easy access to a range of quality facilities including:

- Charging station for phones and power banks

### Keeping Warm & Cosy

- Comfy pillows, cotton sheets, duvet covers & pillowcases
- A large bath towel per person

**Top tip:** Pack warm pyjamas, cosy clothes, and perhaps a blanket or throw **nights can get chilly.** 

# Security

- On-site staff available 24/7
- Wristbands must be worn at all times staff may ask to see them
- Hotel Bell Tents is not responsible for lost or stolen items we recommend locking valuables in your car/bike luggage boxes or leaving them at home
- Key padlocks can be purchased at Reception

# Site Rules & Safety

To keep everyone safe and the site pleasant for all:

- No glass: Glass containers are not allowed. You'll need to decant drinks into approved containers at the gate
- No BBQs of any kind: Gas, charcoal, disposable or portable these are strictly prohibited
